A Message from Our Principal

Dear SFX Parents,

I am writing to inform you about our <u>revised cell phone policy</u> for the 2025-26 school year. *Please review this policy with your child.* By working together as a team, both school and parents, we can create a phone-free environment that minimizes distractions and keeps the focus on each child's education.

Last year, at the Parent Commitment Meeting held at the Grand Unity Event Center, I recommended reading "The Anxious Generation" by Jonathan Haidt (click here to order from Amazon). In his book, Haidt discusses how smartphones and social media are negatively impacting young people, emphasizing that digital experiences are a poor substitute for real-world interactions and play, crucial for developing social skills and a healthy emotional life. There is more and more emerging evidence that suggests that delaying the age in introducing cell phones to children can have great benefits for cognitive development, social emotional development and mental health.

SFX has maintained a phone-free policy for many years. However, with the introduction of new technologies like smartwatches, which can receive texts, stream videos, and access the internet, we are reintroducing the very distractions our cell phone restrictions aim to prevent. **If devices are brought into the school, they need to be kept in backpacks for the duration of the school day.** On behalf of our staff, thank you for your partnership and support of this policy and in helping us to minimize distractions during the school day.

REVISED Cell Phone & Communication Device Policy

Restricted use of cell phones and smartwatches

Cell phone and smartwatch use is strictly prohibited for use by students at school **If a student must** bring a cell phone to school for after school use, they must remain powered off or in silent/airplane mode and stored in their backpacks or lockers from the start of the school

day until dismissal (last bell). A smartwatch is any watch that receives messages or notifications and/or connects to the internet and is subject to the same restrictions as a cell phone.

Prohibited uses during school hours

Cell phones and smartwatches are not to be used at school during the school day from 7:55 a.m - 3:05 p.m. This restriction also applies to non-instructional times, including lunch, recess, passing periods, and in restrooms. Recording audio or video of others without permission from authorized staff is prohibited.

Communication with students during school hours

Parents or guardians who need to contact their children during school hours should call the front office, and the message will be relayed. In emergencies, parents can still reach their children through the front office.

Consequences for policy violations

Violating this policy will lead to disciplinary actions:

-First offense: Parents will be notified and the device will be kept in the school office for the remainder of the school day until a parent can pick them up.

Second offense: parents will be notified, the phone stays in the office for the remainder of the school day until a parent can pick them up, and the student will serve a <u>one hour detention</u>. A meeting may be held with the student, parent, and administration to create a cell phone plan moving forward.

-Third offense: the parents will be notified, the phone stays in the office for the remainder of the school day, student will serve one half-day of in school suspension, a cell phone plan will be created which stipulates that device must be turned into the office at the beginning of the school day and retrieved at the end of day dismissal.


