October Virtue of the Month - Fortitude

This month, our school community is reflecting on the virtue of fortitude Fortitude is the strength of mind and heart that helps us to <u>do what is right</u>, <u>even when it is</u> <u>difficult</u>. It is the courage to persevere through challenges, to resist temptations, and to remain faithful to God's will in the face of adversity. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that fortitude "ensures firmness in difficulties and constancy in the pursuit of the good." For children, this virtue is especially important as they grow in faith, face peer pressure, and learn to make choices that reflect their values.

Fortitude in Daily Life at School & at Home

Students can practice fortitude in many ways:

- Standing up for what is right, even if it is unpopular.
- Persevering in homework and responsibilities, even when the work is challenging.

- Speaking the truth, even when it's difficult
- Choosing kindness and forgiveness, even when it is easier to stay silent or hold a grudge.
- Trusting in God's plan, especially during times of uncertainty or difficulty.
- Share stories of saints who lived with courage and faith, such as St. Joan of Arc, St. Maximilian Kolbe, or Blessed Carlo Acutis.
- Pray together for the strength to face challenges with trust in God.

The Bible reminds us that God strengthens those who trust in Him. Fortitude is not about relying on our own power alone, but about allowing God's grace to give us courage. Through prayer and faith, we can face trials with confidence, knowing that God is always with us. "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go." – Joshua 1:9
